Opening Prayer: Fr. Fred led the meeting with a prayer followed with reflection among the members.

Review and Approval of Minutes: The minutes from June 16, 2025 were approved.

Review of the Planning Calendar for 2025:

Events early in the 2025 calendar year discussed in more detail were:

- Sept 20th Hispanic Ministry Event
- Sept 26th Putting & Pizza: Venue: Putting World, 16259 Scottsdale Rd.
